



A GUIDE TO EBBISHAM SQUASH LEAGUES

Ebbisham Squash and Racketball section welcomes new members of all ages from beginners to experienced club players. Membership allows you access to use the courts, access the online booking system and to participate in the internal leagues for both squash and racketball, both of which are run by volunteers.

The internal leagues allow members to play at an appropriate level and aim to improve. The squash leagues consist of approximately 5 players per league and all games should be played in the calendar month. To get the most out of your membership we encourage all members to join the leagues and we welcome Squash and Racketball players for all levels.

- Leagues are managed using the Online Booking System which is accessed using your member login and password



- Squash Leagues are run on a calendar month
- To view the leagues, you need to be logged in to the online booking system and from here you can see your opponents and entered results.
- The league table provides you full contact details for your opponents, please ensure you have given consent on the website for your details to be shared.
- You can enter results of games and if errors are made just re-enter them
- Results are entered on games won and points will be awarded automatically according to the table below.
- Results must be entered before 10pm on the last day of each month.
- Leagues consist of 5 players per league on average. Though this may vary depending on the total number of participants.
- At the end of each month 2 player are promoted and 2 players are relegated however this will vary based on people joining and withdrawing from the leagues.
- Leagues will run as normal through club championships and holiday periods.

LEAGUE CUP

All players are automatically entered into the League Cup. The League Cup is awarded to the player with the most points gained in the leagues between September and the Squash Championships (usually April) .



RULES / SCORING:

- Matches are best of 5 games, Scoring uses PAR (Point a Rally) scoring up to 15, if the score reaches 14-14 the game continues until one player leads by two points e.g. 16-14 or 17-15.
- Each player is responsible for arranging the game. Every effort should be made to arrange and play the game.
- Either player can enter the score, but the onus is on the winner to enter the result to get the points.
- The following table shows the points allocated based on the outcome of each match:

- When entering your score on the booking system please enter the Score in games.
- Scores can be re-entered if mistakes occur on entering the score

If matches are not played:

- If a player does not turn up for an arranged match (without prior notice), they will be awarded 0 points and the opponent 3 points
- If a match is confirmed and needs to be cancelled and it is not possible to rearrange then the player canceling forfeits the game and the opponent takes a walkover
- If players are unable to arrange matches, then common sense should apply. The objective should be fair to both the players and the other members in the league
 - If one player is not available to play the game, then a walkover should be given to the player who is available
 - If both players are just unable to play the game, then it should be entered as a draw.
- Please do not agree a score other than a walkover or draw as this is unfair to others in the league.
- If a score is not entered it is assumed that it has not been arranged and a 0-0 result is declared

How Final League Positions are decided:

1. Leagues are decided on total points won.
2. If points are equal, then the result is next decided on the head-to-head match.
3. Next decision point is decided on total points against.
4. Finally, if players are still not separated then current league position is used as this is based on the last league results.
